Types of presentations

The ICISS 2017 conference will be held with participations "in person" or "virtually" by poster or videoconference:

1- In person

You may submit your proposal to the Conference Committee for presentation in person. The committee will decide if your presentation will be by Poster or PowerPoint presentation. If you will present with poster you should print the poster by yourself in the format 50x70 cm.

2- Virtual Presentation

If you choose to participate through virtual presentation, your presence is not required. You can send your presentation by poster (in pdf format) or send your presentation through videoconference. Your presentation by poster or videoconference will be uploaded in the conference website. All materials in this case (certificate and proceedings) will be sent by poste in your address.

You may send also the full paper if you need the proceedings with full papers. Take into consideration that the full paper should **not exceed 10 pages.** Full papers should be sent before June 30, 2017.
